Exceptional students

As a senior history major at NNU, Lance Corporal **Dallas Beaty** was the top recruit in his graduating class and was awarded the U.S. Marine Corps Commandant's Trophy for his notable leadership.

Recent graduate **Brenda Jackson**, National Merit Finalist and President's Scholar, now studies developmental psychology in a doctoral program at the University of Notre Dame.

Team Super-Hydro, a group of six sophomore engineering students, flew on the "Vomit Comet" while conducting an experiment as part of NASA's Microgravity University System Engineering Educational Discovery (SEED) program. Students tested new superhydrophobic nanomaterials in zero-g and documented their findings using a high-speed camera.
